Bringing Professional Theatre to Oceanside


Oceanside Theatre Company (OTC) is the professional production company in residence at the historic Brooks Theater in downtown Oceanside, California. OTC is a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and a federally recognized 501(c)(3) charitable organization.

Our mission is to:

- produce professional theatrical productions for the entertainment and enrichment of our community,
- present educational opportunities in the arts for children and adults; and
- provide a venue for expansion of artistic endeavors in north San Diego county.

Serving as a Vital Cultural Link

An important part of OTC's mission is to perform community outreach, thereby inspiring and sharing the arts with our youth. Filling the gap left by the elimination of arts education in local schools is critically important.

To help accomplish our mission, OTC runs a four-week Youth Academy (OTCYA) during the summer and performs outreach with local schools during the school year.

The theatre also serves as an integral part of the many Oceanside art and cultural institutions: Oceanside International Film Festival, Art Walk, Oceanside Museum of Art and MainStreet Oceanside.

Of all the cities in California, the Oceanside Cultural District was just recently selected by the California Arts Council as one of California's 14, premier state-designated cultural districts. The Oceanside Cultural partners include: the City of Oceanside, Oceanside Public Library, Oceanside Arts Commission, Oceanside Friends of the Arts, Oceanside Museum of Art and MainStreet Oceanside. OTC is closely linked with all these cultural partners.

Research has shown that a high concentration of the arts in a city leads to higher civic engagement, more social cohesion, improved child welfare, and lower poverty rates. Plus, students involved in the arts show improved academic performance, lower dropout rates and better attitudes about community service.


Driving Economic Development

Visual and performing arts attract tourists and locals alike to the theatre and its surrounding restaurants and shops. Art travelers are ideal tourists - staying longer and spending more. The typical arts attendee spends \$24.60 per person, per event, not including the cost of admission, and attendees outside the county spend twice as much.

Nonprofit arts organizations generate \$135 billion in economic activity annually, supporting 4.1 million jobs and generating \$22.3 billion in government revenue.

Celebrating Our Rich Oceanside History

The Brooks Theatre has a rich history deeply rooted in Oceanside. The building had been a butcher shop, a drug store, a barbershop, a billiard parlor, and yes - a theatre.

1936 to 1948

The Brooks operated as the Margo from 1936-1948, after which it was renamed the "Towne Theater."

1950's to 1970's

The Towne was one of three downtown movie houses that operated through the 50's, 60's and 70's.

1993 to 2011

The City of Oceanside acquired the theatre in 1993 from Hattie Hazel "Sunshine" Brooks, from whom the current name originates. A local group of thespians answered a call from the city in 1995 and moved into the building as the Pacific Coast Players. The Players called the Brooks their home for five years. The theatre went black for a year during construction. New Vision Theatre Company managed the Brooks for six years after the theatre construction was completed.

2011 to 2016

Oceanside Theatre Company formed in January of 2011 and was awarded management for the next five years.

2016 to Present

In 2016, a new OTC Board of Directors and Artistic Director were appointed and a new mission and vision established. The new Board has two primary goals, namely:

1. To engage and collaborate with the thriving local arts community, residents, and commerce making Oceanside and OTC a beacon for the arts in North County; and
2. To restore the historic Brooks Theatre.

The rich history of the Brooks is one with many ups and downs, and it is an honor to be a part of its revitalization. We hope that the men and women, whose dream was to bring brightness to their town, will be pleased with our efforts to make the Brooks and Oceanside Theatre Company a regional cornerstone for the arts.
